JOB DESCRIPTION

JOB TITLE: Youth Worker

RESPONSIBLE TO: Youth Worker, SWAY

JOB ROLE: To assist the Lead Youth Worker in the development, delivery and management of youth work across the SWAY area

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:

To work predominantly in a rural area directly with 10 – 18 year olds to enable them in their personal development and social education by offering a range of positive activities.

- To assist the Lead Youth Worker to develop and deliver youth work in the SWAY area including supporting :-
 - Drop-in youth clubs (minimum 3 nights a week)
 - Residential events, such as Lakes trip Corf, Young Leaders and participating with YFC
 - Schools work in SWAY area Primary Schools such as assemblies, after school groups and lunch times.
 - Mentoring, 1:1 support alongside our Youth & Families' Support Worker
 - To encourage young people to explore faith in a creative and dynamic way
 - Plan and develop programmes and activities in conjunction with the SWAY team
 - To support and supervise young people in their community volunteering role
 - Support and deliver Young Leaders, and 14+ Project, including training
- To undertake any relevant training to aid personal development and effectiveness
- To maintain and develop key working relationships through outreach work and links with the range of statutory and voluntary sector organisations where appropriate

- To work within and actively promote equalities; and to ensure the health, safety and welfare of staff and participants, in accordance with SWAY's policies and procedures
- To input effective monitoring and evaluation information to provide reports and undertake supervision as required
- To support and work in accordance with SWAY aims, purposes and policies
- Carry out from time to time any other appropriate duties as required by the Lead Youth Worker to support and promote the work of SWAY, in accordance with the post holder's capabilities
- To provide management information for the Lead Youth Worker as required.
- To be able to work within the Christian Ethos
